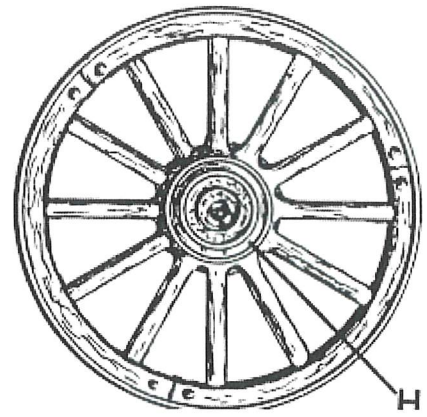

GROUP VOLUNTARY LIFE INSURANCE

PLEASE
READ

I am currently working with a vendor to put together a group voluntary life insurance option for benefit eligible team members.

I already have coverage that the company pays for, why is this important?

- The company pays for eligible team members to receive \$50,000.00/year term life insurance coverage. **THIS IS AWESOME!** However, most people find that they need more coverage than that and would also like to cover their dependents.

Why is it beneficial to purchase life insurance through the group benefit vs. through my insurance agent?

- When you have a group policy, there is a certain amount of coverage guaranteed – meaning that if you apply for it, the insurance company has to approve it because you are part of the group. If you purchase an individual policy it doesn't have to be approved which makes it hard for people that are past a certain age or have had certain health issues.
- There are also tax advantages to having your premiums payroll deducted.

What if I want more life insurance than the guaranteed amount?

- If you want more coverage than the guaranteed amount you can apply for it but would need to complete an evidence of insurability – typically a physical for the insurance company to review before approving your enrollment/coverage.

Why do I need to know this?

- In order to get a group plan we have to have a certain number of team members enroll or the insurance company won't let us offer a group plan. If this is something you are interested in, please reach out to Amber Schaefer and she will make sure to keep you posted!
